

## **WILMOT NEXT GEN TEAM**

**Position:** Sunday School Helper

Time Commitment: Serve once a month during the 11 AM service, youth are invited to class after

worship so you will have approximately 30–45 minutes of time with them.

Arrive 10–15 minutes early to connect with the teacher and prepare.

**Purpose:** To assist the Sunday School Teacher in creating an environment where grade 6–8

students can get a little deeper into God's Story and continue to discover their unique place within it. This role is primarily focused on facilitating discussion and

guiding discovery that springs from a video-based curriculum.

**Spiritual Gifts:** Serving, Hospitality, Evangelism, Faith

**Responsibilities:** Support the Teacher: Help set up and tidy the classroom space. Be present,

attentive, and ready to assist as needed during video teaching, discussions, or

activities.

Encourage Engagement: Sit among the students, model active listening, and

encourage participation by your presence and example.

Foster a Welcoming Space: Help create an atmosphere of openness and respect

where students feel safe to be themselves, ask questions, and share honestly.

Build Relationships: Take time to learn student names, show genuine interest in their lives, and reflect Christ's love through your consistency and kindness.

Be Observant: Watch for any behavioral, pastoral, or safety concerns and

communicate them to the teacher or ministry leader.

Pray and Care: Support the spiritual growth of students by praying for them and

being available for support as appropriate.

Maintain a safe environment by upholding WCC's Plan to Protect policies.

**Accountability:** This ministry falls under the leadership of the Pastor of Next Generations.

Scheduling is done by the Pastor of Next Generations.

For the safety of our youth, all volunteers working with youth need to complete the Plan to Protect training. Don't worry! We will guide you through this onboarding process.
